**Happy Birthday Leo the Lion! For those born between July 23 - Aug 23rd**

The Key Phrase is: I ROAR...oops...only teasing ☺.

**Applause, applause!!**...Leo's love an audience and will often position themselves to be the center of attention. They have a keen need to feel appreciated and to accomplish something in life they feel proud of. Leo is a masculine, fixed (steady and determined), fire (intuitive, fiery) sign located in the 2nd quadrant (other oriented/inter-personal) of the Western Hemisphere of the chart. Because Leo resides in the 5th house of the zodiac and is ruled by our **Sun**, our life force, ego ideal, our future, children, creativity, romance are most important to Leo. Leo loves romance and will shine brightly in most relationships...so long as they are viewed as "King". They can be incredibly charming and have a fun, child-like carefree attitude. Leo is the King of the Jungle!! (or Queen of the office!) The luminary ruling the sign of Leo is our life giving Sun. The Sun shines brightly during the day sky with our moon goddess absorbing his light to reflect back to us in the evening, once the Sun has disappeared from view.

The sign of Leo rules the spine, back and the heart. The heart is associated with emotions and love and Leo's can be absolutely devoted to those they love. The heart chakra is our life force where harmony and trust resides for yourself and others. When our heart chakra is "open" we are flexible and able to both give and receive love. We are open to change and new ideas which leads to personal growth. When feeling hurt, Leo will retreat to their "cave". When our heart chakra is not open we are not able to receive or give love and become off balance.

The glyph/symbol for the sign of Leo is often associated with kundalini energy. This energy is coiled at the base of the spine and is our vital energy.

Since the sign of Leo is symbolic of the Lion I want to celebrate the sign of Leo as symbolic of all cats...large and small. If you stroke Leo the right way (stroking fur in one direction) you will hear Leo purrrrrrr... When cat's purr they show contentment. They do not want their fur fluffed in the wrong direction though! Lions are very protective of their cubs (children). If Leo is prominent in your chart, children will be of primary importance to you.

Leo's polar opposite (5th house - romance, children, creativity, gambling) is the fixed, air sign Aquarius (11<sup>th</sup> house - friendships, organizations, associations, hopes and wishes). The integration of romance, children, and creative outlets versus independence, individuality, friendships and associations are some areas of life for Leo, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite....the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Leo can become erratic, unpredictable and extremely willful and can not be tied down at all...just like airy Aquarius, the water bearer, ruled by the iconoclast planet Uranus. Aquarians often seem distant or cool as they are an air sign and tend to "think" their emotions. At a past AFA conference, I attended a lecture by Kelly Lee Phipps. He's quite an entertaining speaker and an Aquarian himself. He described Aquarius and the Water Bearer symbol like this: The Water Bearer is holding this jug of water, he doesn't know what to do with this water (EMOTIONS), looks around and decides "who needs this?" and tosses the water over his shoulder! Well, when under stress, Leo will toss whatever is troubling him/her over the shoulder too. This can be any emotional issue, but more than likely concerning a relationship/romantic partner.

### THE STRENGTH Card - Number VIII - Leo

**In The Tarot deck, card #8** - is symbolic of the sign of Leo. Here you have a lovely naked woman standing next to a Lion. She is stroking his regal mane, as he appears to be purring like a little kitten!! ☺ This IS Leo! The King of the Jungle can be tamed if you stroke his fur in the right direction. Have you ever pet a real kitty's fur in the wrong direction? They look at you in such away as to imply "HOW DARE YOU!!!" "I am the King or Queen and I expect to be treated the same!" Well...this is Leo!! Puleeeese don't rub their fur the wrong way!

The Strength card represents strength, determination and power. However, in the picture you have a gentle woman, unarmed and without protective armor (unlike the Chariot in card #7 which is "outer strength and will"). This woman overcomes the lion with her quiet strength, the power emanating from within. This card is symbolic of the inner power of the human spirit to overcome all obstacles.

Often this will symbolize calming the beast within as with the use of psychotherapy. Strength, which is essentially female, tunes into her intuition to keep the lion (our unconscious desires) calm and in control. The lion in this card is also symbolic of the courage to encounter powerful forces, to place fear aside and to claim our own power.

When Strength appears in a reading, creative thinking, speaking with honesty and truthfulness are combined to promote the ego and ethical behavior. Taming passions, courage, determination, generosity and having an open heart are indicated.

Negatively, domination, lack of control, wasting time and self indulgence would be possibilities.

**STRONG RIPE BERRIES MOON (Sturgeon)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from July 23 - August 23rd are born during the Ripe Berries Moon! You belong to the Thunderbird Clan. Your plant totem is the **Raspberry** and their animal totem is the Sturgeon! Are you familiar with the sturgeon?? A sturgeon is a really big fish...actually...the KING of fishes! It's a very old and ancient fish that surfaced around the years just after the dinosaurs. Beneath the surface, Sturgeon people are usually very sensitive. They hide this well with their great big smile. Because of their keen intuition and perceptions, they usually feel what others are feeling and can be easily hurt.

The color for this sign is **red** that is associated with the heart and blood and with their gemstone, the Garnet. Garnet is believed to have the vibration power to balance sexual energies. The color red can also symbolize erratic action, excessive pride, sensuality and sexuality, greed and selfishness for those less evolved Leo's/Sturgeon's ☺ People who are of this color tend to have nervous problems during their life.

**August, 2006**

**Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 ½ days.**

**August 9, 2006 - 16 Aquarius 44' FULL MOON.** Expect the unexpected with the energy of this full moon~!

**August 13, 2006 -Venus** in Cancer enters dramatic Leo. Venus in Leo is very attractive and warm hearted. Loyalty, praise and generosity are symbolic of Venus in the fiery sign of Leo.

**August 20, 2006 - 00 Virgo 07" NEW MOON** - New Beginnings in Mercury ruled Virgo; health, pets, details, professionalism, perfectionism and logical solutions symbolize this New moon.

**August 24, 2006 - Sun enters Mercury ruled Virgo.** Happy Birthday Virgo! More will be discussed about Virgo in our next issue.

**August 28, 2006 - Mercury in Leo turns enters Virgo.** Mercury in Virgo is detail oriented and analytical. In this sign you will desire to know all sides of a situation before making any decision. Controls of emotions predominate in this sign.

**Mars continues in the sign of Virgo.** Mars in the sign of Virgo is detail oriented and particular and very sensual. Mars begins the month at 05 Virgo 44' and ends the month at 24 Virgo 44'

**Jupiter in Scorpio** begins the month at 9 Scorpio 56' and ends the month at 13 Scorpio 15'.

**Saturn, lord of karma** begins the month at 14 Leo 01' and ends the month at 17 Leo 49'.

**Uranus** continues to retrograde until November 19, 2006 when it turns direct at 10 Pisces 48'. Electric **Uranus** begins the month at 14 Pisces 02' and ends the month at 12 Pisces 57 rx.

**Neptune** continues to retrograde on until October 29<sup>th</sup>, 2006. Currently at 18 Aquarius 41" and ends the month at 17 Aquarius 53'

**Pluto continues to retrograde** at 24 Sagittarius 23' conjunct the Galactic Center. Pluto will continue his backward journey until September 3, 2006 when he turns direct at 24 Sagittarius 04'. Pluto will end the month at 24 degrees Sagittarius 05 minutes.

#### **SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

#### **FULL MOON - August 9, 2006- 16 Aquarius 44'.**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and

especially in her own sign. Since the August 9th Full Moon falls in the sign of Aquarius, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Aquarius is a fixed, air and resides in the 11th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by electric Uranus. In the sign of Aquarius, this Full Moon will intensify your feelings of independence and freedom and restrictions of any kind will be summarily dismissed. New ideas or flashes of insight are possible. A Full Moon increases in light and is always a culmination of energy.

**SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:**

**Responsible Relationships and Maturity**

Our receptive Moon currently transits in the sign of Leo just having passed her conjunction with responsible Saturn. The Moon in Leo is magnetic and warm while Saturn in the sign of Leo is authoritative and restrictive bringing a certain amount of pride and coolness to the

Moon. However, there is the inclination to assume responsibility with this combination. Having too much responsibility can predispose an individual to feeling a lack of true joy yet without feeling responsibility we tend to ignore the consequences of our behavior and the affect we have on others.

A relationship topic which has come up a lot lately is one where one person in the relationship will self sabotage it so that it will not work. Perhaps they blame their partner for their errors in judgment or lack of responsiveness or project their own bad behavior onto the partner. Now, there are many reasons why relationships do not work. Some of these reasons might be: lack of communication, lack of common goals in life, lack of respect for each other, what you each value may be at odds with each other, dishonesty and sexual infidelity to name a few. However, usually if you are in a relationship for considerable period of time, you get to know this about your partner before you make the decision to completely commit to a longer term or legal commitment.

In fact, there is a wonderful little book written by Osho called "Maturity - The Responsibility of Being Oneself". Sounds like a no-brainer right?? Be a mature and responsible adult - responsible for yourself. I'd imagine that if every partner in a relationship were an emotionally mature and responsible adult, we wouldn't have so many divorces! Osho discusses emotional immaturity and lack of responsibility in the way people form relationships and marriages. He claims we do the reverse; relationships and marriages are formed based upon the fanciful whims of many without regard for reality. "Divorces exist because marriages are done in a romantic mood. A romantic mood is good if you are a poet - and poets are not known to be good husbands or good wives. In fact, poets are almost always bachelors; they fool around but they never get caught, and hence their romance remains alive." "Osho" Osho states that we should never marry when one or both partners is in a romantic mood. He says we should wait for the prose mood to come because day to day life is much more like prose. Now this is a man after my own heart ☺ Finally, someone "gets it"! ☺

Continuing above...so what happens if you are in a relationship with a person who meets your needs, expectations and desires and you meet theirs and visa versa and then one person starts behaving erratically? The person you are involved with starts to not tell you everything and begins concealing aspects of their lives. When you ask though, they deny the behavior and do not validate your perceptions. Perhaps that person starts to "harass" you with more phone calls or knowing that you are unable to talk, intentionally call during those times. They may start to test you or even follow you as if they are suspicious of something that they "think" is going on but isn't happening! The kind, thoughtful individual you thought you were involved with is really quite manipulative and cunning and more self-protective than you imagined.

"Immature people falling in love destroy each other's freedom, create a bondage, make a prison. Mature persons in love help each other to be free; they help each other to destroy all sorts of bondages" - Osho

Not all partners operate on the same level of maturity.

Very often when your partner's unresolved issues and fears from past relationships surface, they will be projected onto you and your relationship with them. Of course, you have no idea what's going on until it begins usually when a longer-term commitment or decision is imminent. They may have lead you to believe they wanted one thing when in reality their fears have them trapped in a vicious cycle of playing the blame game. This means that they do not own their fears, unresolved issues and their instinctual, habitual, negative behavior that often surfaces in intimate relationships. When they do not own their behavior, they disown it. When they disown their negative behavior, they may project it onto you...and of course you will react negatively towards them because of this unpredictable behavior which in hindsight is quite predictable.

Basically these individuals self-sabotage their relationships because of their own fears. However, they will more than likely tell you its all your fault and it was you who is to blame, it wouldn't have worked anyway. This self protective behavior occurs in individuals who have not resolved their past relationship losses or grievances or child of origin issues with their parents. This is why I advise my clients that if they are going to date a newly divorced man or women, make certain you ask a lot of questions and obtain the answers you need to determine if this person is ready for a relationship that involves the level of emotional commitment you seek. If they haven't resolved the problems from their last relationship than you can rest assured the same issues will usually resurface in their relationship with you. These issues can be around who's in charge of things in the household, who pays for dates, children, especially the 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> time around etc. What most newly divorced people don't realize is that the 2<sup>nd</sup> time around is very different than when you were setting up house in your 20's when you were starry eyed and idealistic (see Osho above about romantic poets). Problems arise when you are not honest with your self about your situation and not seeing your partner clearly.

If you're not honest with yourself more than likely you will not be honest with your partner. This kind of behavior allows an individual to disown part of their inner life and attempt to project or dump it onto you. For instance, if your partner hasn't resolved anger and resentment issues and they don't want to feel the anger and resentment over past failures etc, they will unconsciously dump it onto you...transfer those feelings onto you. If you buy into it then you can literally act it out for them. Then of course, they will berate you for those behaviors they elicited in you! Co-dependent's, Borderline's and Passive-Aggressive behavior all fall under this category. However, anyone can maintain self-sabotaging behaviors based upon the successful or unsuccessful resolution of childhood/parental imprints and the cumulative relationship history of the partner. Setting healthy boundaries with Rebirthing, Spiritual Guidance, Astrological Counseling and Behavior Therapy can heal these wounds.

In addition to working and returning to school full time, my daughter and I have been involved in looking at colleges for her. In addition, I am in litigation with my ex husband again over his noncompliance with various past Court Orders in addition to not paying his Child Support. He also feigned a mental illness, (after receipt of an Enforcement Motion and possible Bench Warrant) hired a partner from a law firm who then hired a Psychiatrist to "try" to prove his case, all in response to his having received an Enforcement Motion for back support from me and knowing that payment of college tuition must be decided within the upcoming year. Unfortunately in New Jersey and across the Country, thousand and thousands of "dead beat" parents escape their responsibility for the care of their children. The vicious cycle that plays out in the Courts is tedious, time consuming, psychologically stressful and financially devastating. Children have a right to have their emotional, psychological and financial needs met.

In NYC, a physician who was going through a divorce decided that he would set his building on fire and kill himself because he would rather die than go through his divorce and divide the marital assets. In the town by which I reside, another man was served with divorce papers and decided to take his children to a family member's home and then murdered his wife then killed himself. Some men will do anything to control an outcome and not pay support. For those of you familiar the history of this situation, my ex husband is one of

those dead beat dads we read about in the newspaper who will do anything to not support his child. That his highly compensated wife both enables and encourages his non compliance by financially supporting his "cause" is even more insidious. It is my belief that for those children born in the 80's with Uranus, Neptune and Saturn conjunct in Capricorn that part of their life path is in dealing with patriarchal inconsistencies and outmoded legal processes.
