**Happy Birthday Scorpio the Scorpion!** (Happy Birthday to my Scorpio Mom ☺) to all of those born between October 23 - November 22! Key Phrase for Scorpio is **"I DESIRE"**

Scorpio abhors phoniness and can usually spot a lie before it is even uttered in word. They are usually honest and loyal. Scorpio Rising (ascendant) individuals usually have angular facial features and are easily recognized by the eyes. The expression "the eyes are the window of the soul" might be considered the hallmark of one with planets in the sign of Scorpio...and with a twist. You might say that Scorpio Rising people have the unique ability to see into the soul of "others" with their penetrating gaze.

Scorpio's polar opposite (8th house - sexuality, taxes, values of others, others finances, inheritances, death and endings) is the fixed, earth sign Taurus (2nd house - values, finances, aesthetics, issues around personal security). The integration of my values and finances versus others values and finances and security issues are some areas of life for Scorpio, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite....the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Scorpio can become ...just like fixed earthy Taurus, ruled by Venus.

The sign of Scorpio is ruled by our icy planet Pluto. Some astrologers still utilize the original ruler Mars as Scorpio's ruler. Pluto is considered the higher octave of Mars in traditional astrology. They are sometimes associated with the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> charkas where instincts and survival issues are centered, 8<sup>th</sup> house versus 2<sup>nd</sup> house issues.

Pluto was discovered in 1930. This was a period of time when the atom bomb, made from plutonium, was being developed. The United States was in the midst of a Depression and Psychoanalysis and Depth Psychology were emerging. Pluto is symbolic of psychoanalysis. The function of Pluto is to transform, liberate and motivate. Sigmund Freud's theories on

sexuality and Carl Jung's theories of transformation (Pluto) were formulated. Hypnosis, probing the hidden recesses of our mind is also related to Pluto. Both Freud and Jung have Pluto prominent in their birth chart. Additionally, Pluto was assigned to rule the sign of Scorpio since both the planet and its sign are related to the underworld. (underneath and hidden from view)

Pluto is the planet of power, obsessions, transformation, the depths, what's underneath, sexuality and the value, instincts necessary for survival. Pluto/Scorpio is nothing if not intensely passionate and penetrating. The superficial holds absolutely no appeal for those born under the sign of Scorpio...these guys are "deep" and penetrating...and just try to pull one over on them and you will have an enemy for life. Frankly, you may not know this about them because they have the ability to conceal and cloak themselves in (self protective) secrecy quite well. The planet Pluto ruling the sign of Scorpio is all about redefining and transforming the mundane and outmoded. Scorpions usually have a great many talents and interests ie: research, psychology, metaphysics, analysis and scrutiny of any kind. Scorpio resides in the 8<sup>th</sup> house of the natural zodiac and so also rules our sexuality and the sexual and reproductive organs of the body. Most Scorpions exude sexuality and are magnetically attractive to others. They have the reputation for being the sexiest sign in the zodiac and the most intense!! And what about sex??...mystical and spiritual sexuality!!...can you say Kama Sutra???

When Pluto transits your birth chart or if Pluto is significantly placed in your birth chart, you may experience a sense of loss during your lifetime. Sometimes something of value is taken away from us or we are forced to make a decision to give up something or someone we thought we could not live without. Sometimes these experiences or decisions "feel" like they are a death. Pluto experiences force us to go down as far as we can go and hit "bottom". Things and people that made us feel safe and secure are no longer. Most often these "things" aren't material in nature. They are usually beliefs and attitudes about ourselves and about life, perhaps how we experience others or one person in particular. Because Pluto is so slow moving and has its retrograde (backward motion) phases, it is possible for him to pass over a point in your chart 3 times before he has completed his transformation. When Pluto transits are felt, very often you may feel as if you are descending into unknown territory..and very often you are. It doesn't feel safe yet you know on some deep level that you need to get there. In mythology, the descent into the underworld is classically the feminine archetype. Ariel Guttman and Kenneth Johnson's Mythic Astrology refer to this descent as flows: "It represents the acquisition of serpent wisdom, which is defined as feminine wisdom. Medusa had serpents in her hair and Scorpio, the sign traditionally associated with the serpent, is ruled by Pluto. Thus the process of initiation through pain, grief, darkness and emotional resurrection is an essentially feminine process. Men don't do well with this particular journey". Pluto experiences and transits are for the growth of the soul and are transformational in nature. Those of you who have Pluto prominently placed in your chart have probably experienced acceleration in your personal evolution.

Tarot Card # 20 XX - Judgement - Symbolic of Pluto

The Symbol of Judgment may appear in a reading during a time of soul testing. You may need to adjust to new circumstances based upon a changed awareness. In the Rider-Waite version, Angel Gabriel sounds a trumpet as he creates air. Air is equivalent to breath. There are seven lines or tones radiating from his trumpet = sounds of do re mi fa sol la ti do. The people below, man, child and woman raise their arms up to the Angel as their spirits unfold. Their gray bodies are symbolic of wisdom.

This card can symbolize something lying dormant within us is emerging. Some unconscious truth is being awakened and brought to our awareness. Perhaps we lacked clarity and now we can easily see the way to truth. Judgment usually speaks of a time of reckoning, bringing to light that which was hidden. Darker aspects of our personality may have been repressed or stuffed down inside out of fear. Perhaps this is a time to judge not only your own motives and that of the person in question in your reading.

**FREEZE UP MOON (Snake)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from October 23rd- November 22nd are born under the Freeze Up Moon and their animal totem is the Snake. Their gemstone Malachite is thought to have spiritual powers and increases receptivity to all forms of subtle energy including psychic energy. Their color is orange and their mineral is copper. Copper is attributed with many special powers. For years, people who suffer from arthritis will wear copper bracelets or anklets to ease the stiffening of the joints. Copper also conducts electricity better than most other minerals and is usually utilized in electrical wiring. It also conducts heat more uniformly than most over a variety of surfaces and is why you will often see this coating underneath pots and pans.

Snake people have great ability to aid in others growth. Snakes are very adaptable to their environment. They are highly sexual beings, and very sensitive to touch and vibrations, partly because they are cold-blooded and use their environment for warmth. Because snakes have a prickly outer skin, people tend to not want to get too close to them. Once others realize the outer skin is only a protection for their inner sensitivity they will start to develop a closer relationship with Snake people.

NOVEMBER 2003

October 25, 2003 through March 7, 2004 - Saturn turned Retrograde at 13 Cancer 14 Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. In relationships, while Saturn is retrograde (backward motion) Saturn wants us to rethink and finish up any obligations or promises we have made that do not suit our purpose. If commitments made are no longer working then its time to set limits set boundaries about what we expect. If a

relationship is not working, this is the time to let it go. Saturn ends up the month at 12 degrees Cancer 9.

October 31, 2003 - Happy Halloween!!

November 2: Venus enters Sagittarius - Venus in Sagittarius loves adventure and spiritedness. Venus in fire is wildly romantic and imaginative. Friendship is important for this Venus.

November 8-9: Harmonic Concordance - Consciousness is shifting. Everyone is talking about the grand sextile in the celestial heavens. Planets including Chiron are forming a 60 degree link across the zodiac. This event is happening at the same time as our Full Moon Lunar Eclipse with Uranus going direct! Also in the mix are asteroids Juno (devotion and commitment) and Vesta (service, dedication and focus) forming a triple conjunction with Venus at 7 degree of Sagittarius!

November 8: Lunar Eclipse/Full Moon in Taurus/Scorpio - Eclipses occur in 19-year cycles. Lunar Eclipses are usually experienced on an inner level. Renewal and cleansing of unconscious "baggage" is often cleared. If this Lunar Eclipse conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this eclipse on a very deep soul level. Eclipses always "illuminate" the area of life it contacts in your chart making way for changes and new opportunities.

November 8: Uranus Stationary Direct - Uranus goes direct at 28.54 degrees Aquarius - Uranus goes direct, finally!! Any planet in his path will be affected by sudden shifts and change. Initially oppositions of 0-4 degrees of Virgo will be affected then 2-4 degrees of Gemini and Sagittarius (the squares). As Uranus moves out of the sign of Aquarius, his opposite Leo will be greatly impacted as well as the squares of planets in 28, 29, 30 degrees Taurus and Scorpio. Uranus has been rather disruptive in Aquarius and has been trouble causing for some with planets in Leo. Rest assured that Uranus, when entering the sign of Pisces, will not transit the sign of Aquarius again in your lifetime ☺

November 11: Mercury enters Sagittarius - Thoughts turn to philosophical truths in the sign of the Centaur. Mercury in mutable fire is flexible and intuitive and willing to process, balance and weigh incoming information.

November 22, 2003 - Sun enters Sagittarius - Happy Birthday Sagittarius! Sagittarius is mutable (changeable/flexible) fire (intuition and action).

November 23, 2003 - New Moon Solar Eclipse - 1 Sagittarius 14 Eclipses occur in 19-year cycles. Solar Eclipses are usually experienced on an outer level. There may be some identity crisis or feel out of character. If this Solar Eclipse conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this eclipse at the very core of your personality and redirect your spiritual purpose. Eclipses always "illuminate" the area of life it contacts in your chart making way for changes and new opportunities. It is not always the best time to initiate new

projects because the very nature of this eclipse can be one of change and destabilization. Eclipses usually come in pairs and this is the 2nd eclipse in the month of November.

Jupiter stays in earthy Virgo. Jupiter starts the month at 13 Virgo 5 and ends up at 17 Virgo 2. With Jupiter in Virgo, we may take a step back and be more discerning in our expansiveness. Our pleasures may be more reserved, tempered or serious. Jupiter in Virgo will be much more practical and realistic than when in the sign of Leo. All of the Virgos out there should be receiving some nice benefits with Jupiter in Virgo transiting your Sun.

Neptune starts the month at 10 Aquarius 25 and ends up at 10 Aquarius 48. If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

Pluto starts the month at 18 Sagittarius 17' and ends the month at 19 Sagittarius 17. Whatever Pluto touches in your chart will leave an imprint in your psyche. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul!

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. The symbols were later revised by Dane Rudhyar and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. One of my favorite modern interpretations is written by Lynda Hill. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

FULL MOON TOTAL LUNAR ECLIPSE November 9, 2003 - 16 Taurus 13

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Lunar ruled Cancer is usually more affected by a Full Moon and especially in her own sign. Since the November 9th Full Moon Lunar Eclipse falls in the sign of Taurus, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Taurus is a fixed, earth sign and resides in the 2nd house of the zodiac, ruled by the planet Venus. Issues involving security, finances and income, personal property may be the focus. Lunar Eclipses are usually experienced on an inner level. Renewal and cleansing of unconscious "baggage" is often cleared. If this Lunar Eclipse conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a

natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this eclipse on a very deep soul level.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 17 Taurus:

A SYMBOLICAL BATTLE BETWEEN 'SWORDS' THE DISCIPLES OF MIGHT, AND 'TORCHES', THE DISCIPLES OF ENLIGHTENMENT

Here you have the symbol of the Sword and the symbol of the Torch. Swords are typically utilized in battle. They are sharp, double-edged and cutting. Symbolically, the mind is also a double-edged sword and often our negative thoughts can create a negative reality. Swords are powerful weapons while torches are tools of illuminating light or enlightenment.

There is a "battle" between these two symbols. Where are you feeling the need to battle and defend our position in your own life?

NEW MOON SOLAR ECLIPSE November 23, 2003 - 1 Sagittarius 14

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon. This New Moon is also a Solar Eclipse Moon! There is an extra amount of energy to be assimilated. Eclipses can be felt a week in advance and usually up to a full year afterwards. I have seen the action of eclipses make its mark within 7 days, 3 months, 6 months, 9 months after it "hits" the birth chart. Eclipses always "illuminate" the area of life it contacts in your chart making way for changes and new opportunities. It is not always the best time to initiate new projects because the very nature of this eclipse can be one of change and destabilization. Eclipses usually come in pairs and this is the 2nd eclipse in the month of November.

Since Scorpio rules the 8th house, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be finances, sexual issues, value systems of those you are involved with, tax issues, inheritances and investments and psychotherapy...self-analysis.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 2 Sagittarius:

THE OCEAN COVERED WITH WHITECAPS

One can usually see whitecaps on the ocean when it is very windy outside and there is turbulence in the sea. Sometimes a storm is brewing and we need to run to shore. Storms at sea often happen very quickly and take us by surprise. It is actually usually safer much deeper under the sea than on the surface.

This image seems to be one of blowing out of control. Water and oceans are symbolic of emotions. Like the sea, our emotions can fluctuate and rage out of control. Emotional storms are like tidal waves with peaks and lulls. It is important to stabilize your emotional

storm so that you are able to make decisions that could be life altering or even saving. Avoid over reacting and go with the flow.
