**Happy Birthday Gemini!** For those born **between May 20th - June 19th**

The Key Phrase is: **I Think**. The astrological glyph is the Twins. Gemini is a mutable (malleable, flexible), air (intellect, detached, fleeting) sign located in the 1<sup>st</sup> quadrant (self oriented/personal) of the Eastern Hemisphere of the chart. Because Gemini resides in the 3<sup>rd</sup> house of the zodiac and is ruled by the planet Mercury, communication, thoughts and learning are most important to Gemini. Intellectual stimulation is as basic as water to a Gemini. There is an inherent need to know and understand just about everything. As we discussed in the last issue, the sign of Aries inhabits the 1<sup>st</sup> house of the natural zodiac. That first house is the cusp of the Ascendant or as many already knows as the Rising Sign. Because Gemini arrives immediately after the earthy 2<sup>nd</sup> house Taurus who asks, "What should I possess or own and how will I meet my security issues"? Gemini now desires to communicate and formulate ideas about what those security needs are and present them to others. Most often in the early school years when we accumulate a lot of information about life and the world in a short time frame. Gemini wants to collect data and information about everything. It is not uncommon for a Gemini to be watching television, listening to music and reading a book all at the same time!

Gemini is a dual sign...dual meaning the astrological glyph (symbol) for Gemini looks like this "II"...like the Roman Numeral II - The Twins. Duality means to have a double nature, character or purpose and/or is composed of two parts. Gemini's certainly have the reputation for the ability to change their personality in an instant and can be scattered in their energies. Their duality enables them to see two sides of problem or situation and to often project outwards, the two aspects of their persona as well.

Gemini resides in the 3<sup>rd</sup> house of the zodiac and also relates to siblings, the neighborhood, short distance travel and automobiles. If you have no planets in your 3<sup>rd</sup> house, look to

where the ruler of that house (the cusp ruler) is located and, along with its aspects, this will give you a glimpse of where your communication style and learning experiences are found.

Gemini in health issues relates to the lungs hands and fingers and the nervous system. Respiratory troubles may be more common with Gemini. Sometimes Gemini's just can sit still because they have a lot of physical and mental nervous energy. Gemini's are distinguishable by their youthful exuberance. Gemini always looks a bit younger than their chronological age. Some accuse Gemini of being fickle and/or gossipy....well, Mercury, Gemini's ruling planet does have wings and was considered to be a "messenger".

Gemini's polar opposite (3rd house - communication, thoughts, ideas, early education, short distance travel and siblings) is the mutable, fire sign Sagittarius (9<sup>th</sup> house- higher learning, long distance travel, publishing and the law). The integration of "my ideas and beliefs" versus "other's ideas, beliefs and philosophies" is one life lesson for Gemini, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart.

THE LOVERS - Number VI - Gemini

The Lovers card depicts the unclothed bodies of two lovers, a man and a woman. They bare their souls' to each other. The man gazes upon the woman while the woman looks up to the spirit, Archangel Gabriel. As the angel hovers over the couple, arms and wings spread as if blessing the pair. The sun shines above his head, bringing warmth and security and light. The leaves on the tree mirror the hair on the Angels head...a symbol of the fires of passion burning deep within the lovers' soul. This sun and fire is also symbolic of our life force and our impulse to create. The fertile grass beneath their feet, and fruit on the tree suggests growth and happiness.

However, with all the cards or aspects in a birth chart, there can be negative manifestations of the symbolism of this card. The snake coiled in the tree behind the woman is a gentle reminder of the story of Adam and Eve and the temptations we may be faced with. There are 3 people in this card...not two. In this regard, the third person could be an intruder to the relationship.

Triangulation can occur when there is a choice to be made between two lovers. The Lovers card "is" a card of choices. Choices can be between sexual love and spiritual love although they are closely related. The card can imply the struggling temptation between our immediate material desires versus staying true to ourselves on our spiritual path. There can be a conflict between different forms of attraction. Gemini is a sign of duality and choices.

When we see the Lovers card in a reading, it can augur the coming or presence of a Soul Mate relationship. It mostly represents our most intensely intimate and sexual relationships. Because this is a card of choices, when we see it in a reading it could test our personal beliefs as well as our values within that relationship. We may need to choose between what is right for us and what is wrong for us. This could be an ethical or moral choice. Please see what I have written about **THE DEVIL** card which is the symbolic opposite of the **THE LOVERS** at www.FuchsiaStars.com site listed under Articles/Venus/Pluto.

In the Lovers card, the urge for union is rather powerful and it takes love to the highest spiritual level, symbolic of the Angel. When The Lovers appear, it always refers to a relationship based on a deep, unwavering love. There is no force more powerful. It doesn't always have to be a sexual relationship although the mutual sexual attraction can be unrivaled.

The Lovers card and the number 6 are all about unconditional love, strength, wisdom and compassion. How often do we give love without judgment or strings attached to it?

Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 _ days.

June 3, 2004 - Full Moon 12 Sagittarius 56' - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Sagittarius the focus is on higher education, the law, spirituality and religious issues. Thoughts or decisions about these life issues may culminate during this full moon.

June 6, 2004: Mercury enters Gemini - Mercury in this sign is mentally preoccupied. Thoughts can change and be fleeting. If your natal Mercury is placed here, you are very

sure of your opinions and you like to discuss and communicate your thoughts and theories to others.

June 10, 2004 - Uranus in Pisces will retrograde (rx) - Uranus starts the month at 06 Pisces 45' and will end the month at 06 Pisces 38'. With Uranus retrograde, we will internalize our Uranian energy. The focus may be on an area of study we need to work on for our self improvement. We may feel more self-contained. Planets in Virgo are in opposition to Uranus in Pisces and there may be a reevaluation of your health needs or being of service to others may surface (Virgo)

June 17, 2004: New Moon 26 Gemini 57'. New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. In Gemini, the sign of duality, and the 3rd sign of the zodiac you may want to focus on your communication skills, your siblings and neighborhood.

June 20, 2004 - Happy Father's Day!

June 20, 2004: Sun enters Cancer - Happy Birthday Cancer! Cancer is cardinal (initiator) water (emotions). We will look forward to discussing the sign of Cancer in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

June 24, 2004: Mars enters Leo - Mars in the sign of Leo can be protective of their children. Creativity and romance is highlighted during this time. Mars in the sign of Leo is endurance personified.. Mars here is very proud and dynamic. There may be sudden outbursts attention seeking.

June 29, 2004 - Venus turned direct motion from her backward, retrograde. - While Venus was retrograde, we may have seen the true value of a relationship, object of beauty or friendship. Did any "old loves" resurface during this retrograde to complete unfinished business? Sometimes we don't see the true value of the relationship until we back track over again. However, we can also review the relationship and decide that what we valued in it previously no longer holds any appeal to us. This period of time could be a make it or break it time in all relationships. With Venus retrograde, it was not a good time to purchase things of beauty, or invest in the stock market. Whatever you purchased may have been undervalued or overvalued. It was a good time to purchase a home because it may be undervalued and you may have actually gotten a really good deal on it! Now in direct motion we can think more clearly about our relationships and what we truly value.

Jupiter starts the month at 10 Virgo 09' - Jupiter in Virgo is practical and realistic. All of the Virgos out there should be receiving some nice benefits with Jupiter in Virgo transiting your Sun...try to not overdue it! With Jupiter direct in Virgo, now is the time to earn that extra income with a hobby you enjoy. Attention to detail will improve now as any diet you begin at this time. Jupiter ends the month at 13 Virgo 17'.

Saturn continues in Cancer - Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 12 Cancer 09'. He is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is

also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons. If you have not acted responsibly or with integrity, Saturn is about to make you aware of it by creating some limitation or boundary or lesson. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. He ends the month at 15 Cancer 46'.

Neptune continues her retrograde beginning the month at 15 Aquarius 20' - If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed.

Pluto stays retrograde (rx) - starting the month 21 Sagittarius 52'. Whatever Pluto touches in your chart will leave an imprint in your psyche. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! When retrograde, this energy is turned inward. Pluto will stay retrograde until August 30th and will turn direct at 19 Sag 32'.

SABIAN SYMBOL'S:

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

FULL MOON June 3, 2004 - 12 Sagittarius 56'

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Since the May 4th Full Moon falls in the sign of Scorpio, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Scorpio is a fixed, water sign and resides in the 8th house of the natural zodiac, ruled by planet of power and transformation, Pluto. The values of others, sexuality, money and/or inheritances may come into focus now as well as getting to the bottom of issues is highlighted. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

SABIAN SYMBOL FOR 13 Sagittarius:

A WIDOW'S PAST IS BROUGHT TO LIGHT

This symbol speaks to us about the past coming up for review. Memories of what was past resurfaces. Sometimes when memories from our past resurface from our unconscious they are unsettling. This may cause us to look at a previous situation in a new light. This time of illumination may reveal things better left unsaid.

Healing the past is also a possibility. Once the past or our unconscious is revealed we can take the time to analyze and may expose a new truth. Perhaps you will see why past relationships have failed or should be forgotten.

Past life memories may surface.

NEW MOON June 17, 2004 - 26 Gemini 57'

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon.

Since Gemini rules the 3rd house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be your communication skills, siblings, neighborhood, your automobile, short trips, news, rumors, lungs, shoulders and hands.

SABIAN SYMBOL for 27 Gemini:

A YOUNG GYPSY, EMERGING FROM THE WOODS, GAZES AT FAR CITIES

This symbol shows a woman ready to leave the comfort of their homeland and what is familiar to her.

The cities are far away and out of her reach. She may have to travel far and endure much sacrifice to reach her goal. Once there, there will be new beginnings and this may be both frightening and exciting.

Because Gypsy's are often a bit different, she may not be as readily accepted or she may feel as if her ideas could be dismissed. She doesn't want to be rejected but she is willing to try. Sometimes someone who brings new ideas to a situation is automatically frowned upon yet those new ideas can be incorporated over time.

There are lessons to be learned, either way. Feelings of being out cast, lonely, finding yourself away from home or prophecy and astrology may be the focus ☺

## **SOUL MATES/RELATIONSHIPS:**

Since the planet of love and beauty, Venus, will be so close to the sun on June 8<sup>th</sup> as well as being retrograde (apparent backward motion) I wanted to talk a little bit about her meaning. Venus is traveling backwards in the sign of Gemini. She started out her motion at 26 degrees and will trace steps over every degree in the sign until she reaches 9 degrees before starting her forward motion.

In the birth chart, Venus symbolizes what we value, our financial and security needs that which we are attracted to. Venus in the sign of Gemini is about youth, duality and communication. Venus in Gemini may tend to flirt and tease with words. If you have your natal Venus in the sign of Gemini, you may be attracted to partners with good communication skills. Your partner may be younger than you are or have a youthful self expression. They may be witty and fun loving. Venus isn't only what and who we are attracted to, it is also who we attract to ourselves.

To further narrow it down, you must look at the aspects your natal Venus makes to other planets in your birth chart and whether those aspects (connections and contacts) are challenging (squares, oppositions, conjunctions, quincunx) or easy flowing (trines and sextiles). For instance, you may have Venus in contact with Neptune in your chart but the expression of your Venus in contact with Neptune will manifest differently in a trine as opposed to a conjunction! You would also need to know where Mars is in their chart. Mars is pure energy and how you go after your Venus (what you are attracted to)! That would be how you pursue and act upon your desires. Mars is also your sexuality and how you go after what you want to fulfill your desires. The expression of both Venus and Mars will differ in different zodiac signs.

In choosing a romantic partner, if you know their date, time and place of birth, you can easily see if their love nature, what they are attracted to and how they act and pursue their desires meshes with your own and if they are good for you!

Here are a few examples:

**Venus in contact with Mars:**

Love and competition. Fighting over money. Creative combination. Mars will masculinize the love nature. These people give out strong sexual vibes. Love and anger go together. Often known in extramarital affairs.

**Venus in contact with Jupiter:**

Expansive love nature. Pleasure. Friendly, charming, amenable. Good earning potential. Fun loving. Can be unrealistic and wanting to have fun all the time.

**Venus in contact with Saturn:**

Disciplined or controlled love. Serious in relationships. Aware of appearances in others. Learning about giving and receiving with no strings attached. Affection may have been denied.

**Venus in contact with Uranus:**

Unconventional relationships. Free loving and non committal. Magnetic. Fearful of rejection. Detached. Experimental in love and sex. Self centered and willful in love.

**Venus in contact with Neptune:**

Romantic love and idealism. Fairy-tale romances, clandestine affairs. Concept of the ideal relationship bears no relation to reality ie: the reality of domestic life and living with someone burst the idealistic bubble. What do you mean you are not "perfect?". Also inspired by beauty, art, compassion and peace.

**Venus in contact with Pluto:**

Powerful love. Compulsive affection and jealousy in love and with money. Money and power. Crisis in relationships that are transforming in nature. Often not able to let go of a relationship. Fatal attraction! Fear of rejection.
