**Happy Birthday Scorpio the Scorpion!** (Happy Birthday to my Scorpio Mom ☺) to all of those born from October 23 - November 22! Key Phrase for Scorpio is **"I DESIRE"**

Scorpio abhors phoniness and can usually spot a lie before it is even uttered in word. They are usually honest and loyal. Scorpio Rising (ascendant) individuals usually have angular facial features and are easily recognized by the eyes. The expression "the eyes are the window of the soul" might be considered the hallmark of one with planets in the sign of Scorpio...and with a twist. You might say that Scorpio Rising people have the unique ability to see into the soul of "others" with their penetrating gaze.

Scorpio's polar opposite (8th house - sexuality, taxes, values of others, others finances, inheritances, death and endings) is the fixed, earth sign Taurus (2nd house - values, finances, aesthetics, issues around personal security). The integration of my values and finances versus others values and finances and security issues are some areas of life for Scorpio, also contingent upon other areas of the birth chart. When under stress each sign will operate through the most negative characteristics of their polar opposite, the sign 180 degrees opposite itself. In this case, when under stress, Scorpio can manifest the negative qualities of the fixed earthy Taurus, ruled by Venus. Some of those qualities would be the unique stubbornness, inflexibility and fixity of Taurus..sometimes temper tantrums are possible.

Our icy planet Pluto rules the sign of Scorpio. Some astrologers still utilize the original ruler Mars as Scorpio's ruler. Pluto is considered the higher octave of Mars in traditional astrology. They are sometimes associated with the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> charkas where instincts and survival issues are centered, 8<sup>th</sup> house versus 2<sup>nd</sup> house issues.

Pluto was discovered in 1930. This was a period of time when the atom bomb, made from plutonium, was being developed. The United States was in the midst of a Depression and Psychoanalysis and Depth Psychology were emerging. Pluto is symbolic of psychoanalysis.

The function of Pluto is to transform, liberate and motivate. Sigmund Freud's theories on sexuality (Scorpio and 8<sup>th</sup> house) and Carl Jung's theories of transformation (Pluto) were formulated. Hypnosis, probing the hidden recesses of our mind is also related to Pluto. Both Freud and Jung have Pluto prominent in their birth chart. Additionally, Pluto was assigned to rule the sign of Scorpio since both the planet and its sign are related to the underworld. (Underneath and hidden from view)

Pluto is the planet of power, obsessions, transformation, the depths, what's underneath, sexuality and instincts necessary for survival. Pluto/Scorpio is nothing if not intensely passionate and penetrating. The superficial holds absolutely no appeal for those born under the sign of Scorpio...these guys are "deep" and penetrating...and just try to pull one over on them and you will have an enemy for life. Frankly, you may not know this about them because they have the ability to conceal and cloak themselves in (self protective) secrecy quite well. The planet Pluto ruling the sign of Scorpio is all about redefining and transforming the mundane and outmoded. Scorpios usually have a great many talents and interests ie: research, psychology, metaphysics, analysis, surgery, medicine and scrutiny of any kind. Scorpio resides in the 8<sup>th</sup> house of the natural zodiac and so also rules our sexuality and the sexual and reproductive organs of the body. Most Scorpios exude sexuality and are magnetically attractive to others. They have the reputation for being the sexiest sign in the zodiac and the most intense!! And what about sex??...mystical and spiritual sexuality!!...can you say Kama Sutra??? ☺

When Pluto transits your birth chart or if Pluto is significantly placed in your birth chart, you may experience a sense of loss during your lifetime. Sometimes something of value is taken away from us or we are forced to make a decision to give up something or someone we thought we could not live without. Sometimes these experiences or decisions "feel" like they are a death. Pluto experiences force us to go down as far as we can and hit "bottom". Events, things, beliefs and people that once provided safety and security will no longer under a transit of Pluto. Most often these "things" aren't material in nature. They are usually beliefs and attitudes about ourselves and about life, perhaps how we experience others or one person in particular. Because Pluto is so slow moving and has its retrograde (backward motion) phases, it is possible for him to pass over a point in your chart 3 times before he has completed his transformation. When Pluto transits are felt, very often you may feel as if you are descending into unknown territory, and very often you are. It doesn't feel safe yet you know on some deep level that you need to get there. In mythology, the descent into the underworld is classically the feminine archetype. Ariel Guttman and Kenneth Johnson's Mythic Astrology refer to this descent as follows: "It represents the acquisition of serpent wisdom, which is defined as feminine wisdom. Medusa had serpents in her hair and Pluto rules Scorpio, the sign traditionally associated with the serpent. Thus the process of initiation through pain, grief, darkness and emotional resurrection is an essentially feminine process. Men don't do well with this particular journey". Pluto experiences and transits are for the growth of the soul and are transformational in nature. Those of you who have Pluto prominently placed in your chart have probably experienced acceleration in your personal evolution.

Tarot Card # 20 XX - Judgment - Symbolic of Pluto

The Symbol of Judgment may appear in a reading during a time of soul testing. You may need to adjust to new circumstances based upon a changed awareness. In the Rider-Waite version, Angel Gabriel sounds a trumpet as he creates air. Air is equivalent to breath. There are seven lines or tones radiating from his trumpet = sounds of do re mi fa sol la ti do. The people below, man, child and woman raise their arms up to the Angel as their spirits unfold. Their gray bodies are symbolic of wisdom.

This card can symbolize something lying dormant within us is emerging. Some unconscious truth is being awakened and brought to our awareness. Perhaps we lacked clarity and now we can easily see the way to truth. Judgment usually speaks of a time of reckoning, bringing to light that which was hidden. Darker aspects of our personality may have been repressed or stuffed down inside out of fear. Perhaps this is a time to judge not only your own motives and that of the person in question in your reading.

When this card appears in a reading, you are being asked if your judgments of others are restricting your growth and your ability to create lasting relationships. The need to transform dysfunctional beliefs will elevate you to a higher spiritual vibration.

**FREEZE UP MOON (Snake)**

In Native American Astrology, those born from October 23rd- November 22nd are born under the Freeze Up Moon and their animal totem is the Snake. Their gemstone Malachite is thought to have spiritual powers and increases receptivity to all forms of subtle energy including psychic energy. Their color is orange and their mineral is copper. Copper is attributed with many special powers. For years, people who suffer from arthritis will wear copper bracelets or anklets to ease the stiffening of the joints. Copper also conducts electricity better than most other minerals and is usually utilized in electrical wiring. It also conducts heat more uniformly than most over a variety of surfaces and is why you will often see this coating underneath pots and pans.

Snake people have great ability to aid in others growth. Snakes are very adaptable to their environment. They are highly sexual beings, and very sensitive to touch and vibrations, partly because they are cold-blooded and use their environment for warmth. Because snakes

have a prickly outer skin, people tend to not want to get too close to them. Once others realize the outer skin is only a protection for their inner sensitivity they will start to develop a closer relationship with Snake people.

**November, 2004**

**Our Moon changes signs approximately every 2 \_ days.**

**November 6, 2004 - Mercury enters 00 Sagittarius.** Communications are intense in the sign of Scorpio. The ability to research and delve into the psyche and psychotherapy of all kinds is highlighted. This is a good time self exploration and for personal growth.

**November 8, 2004 - Saturn in Cancer turns retrograde (rx) through March 22, 2005 -** Saturn in Cancer starts the month at 27 Cancer 17'. Saturn is all about our physical structures, restrictions and limitations as well as boundaries. Saturn is also about our commitments to our personal structure. With Saturn in Cancer, the planet in opposition (Capricorn) and in square (Libra, Aries) will be in for some lessons in the areas of life (houses) these signs reside in your birth chart. If you have not acted with integrity or been responsible, Saturn will make you aware of it by creating some limitation, boundary or lesson to re-learn. If you have been working hard, Saturn will possibly set up a task in which you need to prove yourself. Saturn rewards those who have worked hard through difficult times. When retrograde we have the opportunity to finish or renegotiate projects we have started. He ends the month at 26 Cancer 57'. Whatever needs to be redone, reevaluated and reworked will be the focus during Saturn's retreat.

**November 11, 2004 - Uranus in Pisces turns Direct after a long retrograde (rx) -** Uranus starts the month at 02 Pisces 55' and will end the month at 03 Pisces 00'. When Uranus was retrograde, we internalized our Uranian energy. The focus may have been on an area of study we need to work on for our self improvement. We may have felt more self-contained and some of our "electric" energy reverberating inside of ourselves. Planets in Virgo are in opposition to Uranus in Pisces and there may have been a reevaluation of your health needs or being of service to others may have surfaced (Virgo). Now in direct motion, everything that has been assimilated and contained is ready to spring forth in a rather dynamic and unpredictable manner. Do not be surprised and the quickness to which you act and respond to events and people in your life now.

**November 12, 2004 - Mars enters intense Scorpio -** Mars began the month at 23 Libra 14' which is the fixed star degree for Spica - the potential for brilliance. Mars will end the month at 12 Scorpio 33'. Mars in Pluto ruled Scorpio, is possessive, intense, self directed and prone to overcompensating. There is an obsessive quality to Mars in the sign of Scorpio.

**November 12, 2004: New Moon 20 Scorpio 33'.** A New Moon is always a good time to start a new project or work on areas of your life you've let pass. New beginnings are associated with New Moons. In Scorpio, ruled by powerful Pluto, is the 8th sign of the zodiac. This is a positive time deep introspection. You may want to focus on your most

intimate relationships, including sharing values and fiancés with your partner. Undertaking a self growth program is possible.

**November 21, 2004: Sun enters Sagittarius** - Happy Birthday Sagittarius! Sagittarius is a masculine, mutable (flexible) and fire (intuition/action) sign. We will look forward to discussing the sign of Sagittarius in the next issue of Lunar Notes.

**November 23, 2004 - Venus at 3 Libra 14' enters passionate Scorpio.** Venus in Scorpio is intense and sexual in love. We seek a relationship that is intense and passionate and all consuming. Sensuality is heightened and we are more aware of nuances within our intimate relationships. Jealousy and possessiveness in intimate relationships as well as what we need and value so that we feel secure is highlighted.

**November 26, 2004 - Full Moon 05 Gemini 55'** - A full moon is a culmination of energy from the last New Moon, approximately 14 days earlier. In the sign of Gemini the focus is on communication, siblings, the neighborhood, some travel and transportation.

**November 30, 2004 - December 20, 2004 - Mercury Retrograde at 26 Sagittarius 43' conjunct the Galactic Center.** Mercury rules communication, thoughts, newspapers and transportation. Watch for mishaps involving these areas. This is a good time to revise and review but to not take action until Mercury goes direct. Remember to back-up your computers and stay cool when faxes don't get to their intended destination.

**Jupiter** - Jupiter starts the month at 07 Libra 45' and ends the month at 13 Libra 04'. In the Venus ruled sign of Libra, Jupiter is expansive, loving and warm in love matters.

**Neptune starts the month at 12 Aquarius 37.'** Neptune continued her retrograde beginning the month at 12 Aquarius 45 - If you have planets in conjunction (the same sign and approximately the same degree) opposition to this degree (Leo) or in square (Scorpio and Taurus) you will feel the illusive effects of Neptune's transit the most over time. A deeper understanding of what's underneath may come to the surface and your dream life may intensify during this time. The dissolution of boundaries and illusions or the uncovering of the truth will be revealed. Neptune ends at 12 Aquarius 58'. Now direct, expect some shattered illusions, deception revealed and the meaning of those recurring dreams you have been having illuminated.

**Pluto starts the month at 20 Sagittarius 32'** and ends up at 21 Sagittarius 31' on the 30th. Pluto is in a fire sign burning holes in belief systems that no longer suit our life purpose. Pluto is all about personal power and regeneration, throwing out the old and bringing in the new, oftentimes after a complete overhaul! Pluto in Sagittarius is dogmatic and reveals religious, political and philosophical truths. Purging false beliefs in these areas of life has been ongoing.

**SABIAN SYMBOL'S:**

For those of you unfamiliar with the Sabian Symbol, the original Sabian Symbols were written in 1931 by Marc Edmond Jones. Dane Rudhyar later revised the symbols and others have re-interpreted the symbols periodically. Lynda Hill writes one of my favorite modern interpretations. The basis of these symbols is derived from the 360 degrees in the zodiacal circle. Each sign of the zodiac: Aries, Taurus, Gemini and so forth, is comprised of 30 degrees. Since there are 12 signs in the zodiac, that would be 12 signs X 30 degrees = 360 degrees. There are 360 Sabian Symbols and each symbol coincides with and describes each degree of the zodiac. If you know your birth chart, utilizing these symbols for each of your planetary placements is rather telling and will provide you with greater insight into your own character traits and motivations.

### **NEW MOON November 12, 2004 - 20 Scorpio 33'**

New moon = New Beginnings. New Moons augur a time to start new projects. Seeds (ideas and positive energy) planted during a New Moon will culminate and flourish during the Full Moon. In Scorpio, a new understanding of unconscious motivations, money earned for others, legacies and the muscles of the body could be a focus.

Since Scorpio rules the 8th house of the natural zodiac, this New Moon would be a good time to focus and visualize on these areas of your life. Focus may be understanding the values or needs of an intimate partner, death or the passing on of someone, money/income received or psychotherapy.

### **SABIAN SYMBOL for 21 Scorpio:**

#### **OBEYING HIS CONSCIENCE, A SOLDIER RESISTS ORDERS**

Our conscience tells us what we value, what is right and just and appropriate. We need to be true to ourselves and listen to our inner truth. Sometimes society or others have expectations of us that go against what we inherently feel is correct for us. Sometimes people we work for have rules and regulations that go against our belief system. At this juncture there is a choice to be made. We can maintain our integrity in the face of understanding the consequences or we can 'give in' and suffer the consequences of betraying ourselves.

Going against the status quo, upholding your values and being true to yourself is important.

### **FULL MOON - November 26, 2004 - 04 Gemini 55'**

With a Full Moon, we see a culmination or coming to a head the seeds planted during the previous New Moon cycle. Since the November 26<sup>th</sup> Full Moon falls in the sign of Gemini, this lunar energy will be emphasized. Gemini is a mutable, air sign and resides in the 3rd house of the natural zodiac, ruled by winged Mercury. Mercury is one of the two planets who rules two signs, both Gemini and Virgo. Venus is the other dual ruler of both Libra and Taurus. Seeking communication, understanding, learning, siblings, neighbors, news, gossip, all

fall under the domain of Gemini and the 3rd house. These issues may come into focus for you now.

In Gemini, your thoughts may be intensified during this full moon. If this Full Moon conjuncts (same approximate degree) or opposes (180 degrees opposite) a natal planet, you will be more likely to experience the culminating affects of this Full Moon in the area of life (houses) it is located in your birth chart.

**SABIAN SYMBOL for 5 GEMINI:**

**A RADICAL MAGAZINE OR PUBLICATION, ASKING FOR ACTION, DISPLAYS A SENSATIONAL FRONT PAGE**

This symbolizes taking extreme action to illicit a response, to gain attention or a reaction. Sometimes we take extreme measure to gain the attention of a person or cause. This happens often in our political arenas. Sensationalism on all levels exaggerates, and is blown out of proportion. Often the need to reform or change is great and the only way to gain the attention of the masses, unfortunately, is by creating some spectacular headline...which may or may not have anything to do with the "real" issues and masks the underlying message.

Where does 5 Gemini (conjunction-intensity) or 5 Sagittarius (opposition-assimilating from outside -others) or 5 Virgo/Pisces (square-tension) fall in your chart?

Everything happens for a reason. When relationships and life events do not go as we anticipated, it is important to take a step back and evaluate and glean the lesson. Very often we wonder "Why did I lose that job", "Why did this person die on me", "Why did the love of my life suddenly leave?" These are incidences that happen to us. We do not have control over a death of a dear one, or a job layoff and certainly not for the emotions, feeling and judgments a partner projects outward onto you. What we do have control over is how we react, respond and move forward from these disappointments. We can turn a negative into a positive if we ask ourselves, "What is the lesson I need to learn from this disappointment". These events and tragedies do not just "happen" to us for no reason at all. The reasons may not be immediately evident until long after the event, many months or even years later. We can choose to revisit them from time to time until we "get it" and changing negative behavior patterns takes awhile, and only with conscious effort on our part.

When negative things happen around me or people come and go from my life, I take a look at why they appeared in the first place. Not all relationships or jobs are meant to last forever. In fact, in our society and because we all live so much longer, the likelihood of finding "one" relationship, "one" marriage is more of an illusion. We deceive ourselves into believing otherwise. People enter our lives to teach and mirror lessons, as does your own presence in their lives. For example, in April of this year, the manager and owner of the Real Estate company I worked part time was tragically killed along with her husband in an auto accident on the parkway here in NJ. They were childhood sweethearts and lived a long and prosperous life together and even in death, were together. When she died, a chain of events went into motion. Her company was sold and the employees transferred to another Agency with only a 60 day guarantee of employment. I was one of those transfers. After 60 days I would have been unemployed had it not been for a coworker mentioning position

with another local Agency. I was hired there and have a really cool manager who sent me to Real Estate school. This was not an option in previous jobs but is here.

Many years ago I dated a man on and off for two years, the relationship ended abruptly and he married another. This story is rather edited here. Afterwards I received a call 9 months into that marriage that it was a disaster and that he made a big mistake. He continued and still continues to stay in an unhealthy marriage where he is miserable. Part of why he is so miserable is that he doesn't know what makes him happy. He also doesn't believe he can be happy and that if he is it will be taken away and that he is undeserving. If a person can't make themselves happy and does not know what they want and need, how will they know if they have found it in you? When you meet people who are angry, do not practice self love and project their unhappiness onto you, there is no way your relationship with that person can work.

I agree with many friends who tell me that had I married that man would have been the biggest mistake of my life. His marrying another was a blessing in disguise. At the time it didn't feel that way. Time and distance are amazing healers. This person continued to reenter my life every year or so promising to "change", grow and is available for me, but nothing ever did change. In retrospect, I see that his staying in a bad marriage really only mirrors how he feels about himself, what he thinks he deserves or doesn't deserve. I realize that he couldn't possibly be the one for me. During these years in between, this man inspired some thoughts and action on my part. I undertook new areas of study in both astrology and in psychology and lead me to the development of my two websites. On the anniversary of our parting I do something healing for myself, one year I achieved Reiki Level I and then II and then III certifications, another year I attended a Native American "sweat", another year my lecture on the controversial topic of Borderline Personality Disorder was accepted. I lectured at the AFA in Arizona on that topic where this disorder received some recognition amongst the astrological community.

Although "life and events" often seem to "just happen" to us, it is how we experience and work through our personal tragedies that teach us about why they happened in the first place. One of my visually favorite films, amongst many actually, is about a karmic relationship between a man and woman, husband and wife, the sudden death of their children in an auto accident and how that impacted their lives together as well as their psychic connection to each other. I never forgot a line recited in that film, and when life events seem unfair I choose to recall it remember how thankful I am for my gift of love and compassion.
